 to a new location. Good News! Alpine has a **new online rental process** so you
 don't have to go in to rent! Information is at the end of this email. Please read
 and follow carefully.
- By renting from one place we receive a 25% discount, plus one adult will pick up all the equipment and drop off all the equipment when we return (see the additional Alpine information on second page).
- After you have rented your equipment, **please email me** with your contract info. That will insure that we pick up your rental. If I don't get this info, we won't know to pick up your scout's equipment.
- We are still working on getting a group discount for lift passes.
- If your scout is taking a lesson, **please let me know**. We will make separate arrangements for them once we are at the resort.
- Saturday lunch will be prepared by Mr. Parizek. Your scout will not need lunch money during the day.
- Costs are being worked out, but we are shooting for under \$70 for room, food, gas. Lift tickets are about \$45 and lessons around the same. With the lessons, a lift ticket is typically included. Rentals run around \$25. We encourage the scout

to pay for their lift tickets out of their scout account. Email me for balance info.
